


Chili Cook-off

CHANGING PATHS



We certainly did feel welcome during our stateside visit - whether through the signage of a supporting congregation in Florida, through the loving embrace of dear Old Missionary Gary Thies and Mission Central in Mapleton, IA, or simply through walking through the doors of many congregations and being warmly greeted by brothers and sisters in Christ.

"Though a bit bleary-eyed, we arrived safely on Taiwan, in the southern port city of Kaohsiung on Friday, the first of August." These words first appeared in Volume 1 Issue 3 of our Changing Paths newsletter in 2003, thus recording our arrival to Asia 15 years ago this month. This fact wasn't lost on us this summer as we traveled many miles stateside during our Home Service, a trip we normally take once every two years as a family to visit supporting churches, ministry partners, family and friends. Our theme this summer was 'faithfulness' and we shared about how this word is used in Scripture. In the Old Testament, it is closely associated with truth and even undeserved lovingkindness; in the New Testament, the connection is often to trust and confidence. "Your word is truth," says Jesus in John 17 as He prays to God the Father during the Last Supper with His disciples. Indeed, we are granted that truth through the Scriptures. God also showers us with unmerited grace and He gifts us faith to trust in the promises of new life here and eternal life to come in Jesus. We were reminded of these elements of faithfulness during our travels this summer: we were blessed to worship and hear God's Word together with many of you, we were granted travel mercies in every way, and we were able to share stories of faith created in the lives of friends and colleagues in this part of the world. Furthermore, we once again witnessed firsthand warm welcomes, generous partnerships, and refreshing visits. Thank you, dear friends and family - individuals, families, schools, and congregations - for your faithful support of the Wasmund family, serving in your stead in Jesus' name in Asia.
